ITEM NO. 1

CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS VMC MEETING

The Committee reviewed the minutes of the VMC meeting held on 8th August 2010. The Committee was informed about the action taken on the point discussed during the previous VMC meeting. On the issue of maintenance and development the Chairman informed about his meeting with U.P. Jal Nigam representatives where he reviewed the progress of work, which was slow. The Chairman directed that a communication be made to U.P. Jal Nigam under intimation to all regarding slow progress of work and convene a meeting at the earliest.

ITEM NO. 2

ACADEMICS & ACHIEVEMENTS

The Principal was happy to inform the committee that six students had achieved scored 10/10 CGPA in class X examinations and were awarded cash prize of `5000/- each by KVS . The committee was also informed that Summative Assessment- I was held in all the classes and results were distributed on Open day.

Formative Assessment III for the II term was accomplished and the Ist pre-board for class XII was completed. The monthly PTA meeting was conducted. It also informed that Class XII would have remedial class during the winter break commencing from 24th Dec 2010 to 2nd Jan 2011. The IInd pre-board for class XII was scheduled from 3rd Jan to 17th Jan 2011. Career guidance on Secretarial Practices was given to commerce students by Institute of Company Secretaryship . Cmde.(Retired) Nathan guided the students about bright prospects in joining Merchant Navy. Representatives from Proctor & Gamble Company addressed the students in the month of November 2010 on Health & Hygiene . A lecture on AIDS was given by the Medical Officer from Navy to students from classes IX to XI.

SPORTS:

The Committee was informed by the Principal that more than 200 students had participated in Cluster and Regional level KVS Sports Meet.

5 boys and 6 girls from the Vidyalaya were selected for KVS Nationals held at Bangalore and Pune respectively.

Shreya Donadkar of Class IX A and Amulya of Class VIII A brought laurels to the Vidyalaya on getting selected to SGFI in Badminton & Lawn Tennis respectively.

AWARDS:

Dr Vandana Kulkarni, PRT was given KVS Innovation & Experimentation award 2010 in Mathematics and Mrs Latha Devi, HM, was the recipient of KVS Incentive Award 2010 for Primary Teachers.

EXCURSIONS:

Many Adventure activities and excursions were carried out during the session. Primary students were taken on their educational trip to the Nehru Science Centre and local surroundings.

During the month of April 2010, an excursion trip to Mysore, Bangaluru and Ooty was organised wherein 26 students and 3 staff members had participated.

A trekking programme consisting of 30 students and 3 staff members was organized at Pachmarhi during the month of April 2010.

In the month of Oct 2010 , 30 students and 3 staff members went on an Educational Trip to Ajmer, Jaipur, Bits Pilani.

As part of Navy Day Celebration many exciting trips were organized for students. Special programmes were visualised by the students during the

fete.They went sailing, enjoyed sumptuous delicacies,visited the gigantic INS Ganga and were thoroughly captivated by the Grand Orchestra held at Mulla Auditorium , Colaba .The prestigious Beating Retreat performed by the Navy at the Gate Way of India during the dusk hours was cherished by onlookers. The students and the escort teachers expressed their heartfelt gratitude to the Navy for their caring and constant guidance. Principal expressed his gratitude to the Chairman and other Naval Authority who arranged the programme.

MAINTENANCE & DEVELOPMENT:

The Principal informed the Committee that the maintenance and development work of U.P. Jal Nigam was in progress and also informed them that the structural plan of the school building was required from the MES for upgrading the school building. The Chairman directed Principal KV to make a correspondence to Garrison Engineer requesting for a copy of plan to the school, since it was constructed by MES in the year 1998.
